- **Notification:** Nominators of selected recipients will be notified by **Aug. 13, 2025** and asked to submit a <u>3-minute video</u> on behalf of their nominee by **Sept. 12, 2025** for presentation at the inaugural dinner on **Oct. 3, 2025**.
